Parish Matters.

A letter has been sent to the Highways Dept, to ask them to trim the hedgerows on Dark Lane, Wycoller Road, Rock Lane and Burnley Road.

Also a sign to indicate that Dark Lane is a no through road, and one to warn motorists of the bends at Gladstone Terrace.

I have asked for a dog bin at Wycoller Carpark, Colne Road and the Grass verge before Gladstone Terrace.

A letter has been sent to the Highways Dept to ask them if they will strim the grass and weeds down on the Chelsea, Trawden.

A letter has been sent to the Highways dept concerning Rock Lane, we are worried that it may not be able to take all the

traffic for the Agricultural show as it is sinking in places, we think they should have look at it as soon as possible.

Harlington Street is being blocked by two tar-mac wagons, I will have a word with Andy when I see him.

The cleansing team who tidy up the grave yard at Winewall are blocking the lane with their vehicle, I have sent a letter to the cleansing dept to ask if they would park in the parking space provided to avoid upsetting residents.

The new benches on the recreation ground are going rusty, I have asked Alan Bins to go and have a look at them.
