Minutes.

The minutes of the previous meeting of Monday October 6th 2003, were approved and signed. Proposed by Councillor Barry Hodgson, Seconded by Councillor Gillian Greenwood.

Matters Arising.

Tram Tracks, Mr. Andrew Crawshaw attended our meeting, he offered to widen the Tram Tracks and place speed bumps to one side not to encroach onto the cobbles, to make it safer when vehicles are using it, he and other local residents do not want the area closed off, as it has been used as a right of way for over a hundred years. His offer was rejected by the Parish Council, who say it will be used more frequently by vehicles if it is made more accessible.

Since our last meeting there has been a incident with a wagon picking up a loaded skip, which got stuck and had to be towed out by a tractor, a vehicle has also gone through Mr. John Edmondsons fence, a letter has been sent to Colin Badminton asking to do a site visit, suggesting vehicle restrictions, or

for emergency services use only, other suggestions being sprung loaded barrier gates or speed bumps.

Proposed plans for building on the Old Chelsea, Mr. John Birtwistle, we are concerned about the access and think it will be a safety hazard, positioned on a blind bend, it will also take away valuable parking space for other residents - a letter has been sent to the planning Dept.
I will collect a copy of the plans, to be put on the next agenda.
